Chinese Language School – StarTalk Program

STARTALK GOOD WILL PROGRAM is a federal government subsidized language program that provides a vigorous but fun Chinese Language Immersion Program for students at a high school level to learn Chinese as a foreign/second language. It is sponsored by the Southern California Council of Chinese Schools (SCCCS) and funded by the STARTALK project that is managed by the National Foreign Language Center at the University of Maryland, College Park, MD.

This course provides students with understanding of the basic principles of listening, speaking, reading, and writing the Chinese language based on the National Standards for Foreign Language Learning. Also, the students will be given ongoing and varied opportunities to develop their language skills and learn about the richness of Chinese culture through online Moodles (educational instructions), digital media, artistic projects, and cultural activities on Lion Dancing, Chinese Diabolo, Calligraphy, Chinese Crafts, and others.

There are only 16 approved StarTalk school sites in the entire Southern California this year, and our

Chinese Language School is very proud and honored to be selected as one of the sites. We will be working with the Oxnard Union High School District to conduct a summer Chinese Language program held at Rio Mesa High School, 545 Central Ave., Oxnard, CA 93036. Two sessions will be offered: Session I: from 6/19/08 to 7/11/08; Session II : from 7/14/08 to 8/1/08. Class time will be from 8:00AM to 12:00PM Monday to Friday for 4 weeks for each session. OUHSD Students will receive 5 high school foreign language credit posted in their transcript upon completion of the course. Students from grade 7 – 12 are encouraged to enroll in the program. A \$200 material fee is required but will be refunded upon successful completion of the course and verification as student of the OUHSD, VUSD, PVSD. Please see your high school counselors for application form or mail-in the attached application. Class size is limited to 25 students per session, so send in your application ASAP on a first come first serve basis.
